Series Points: Series Points from just 4 of the 6 Day Shows will be accumulated. You choose

Series Levels: Nominate the Level at which you want to compete.

We hope to see you at all six of the shows but only the points earned from your Best 4 classes will be accumulated to decide the Series Winners. If you compete in more than 4 shows you can pick your 4 best scores to count for the Series. In this Series you can only accrue points in your nominated Level

Important notes

- Entries open at www.abderry.co.nz/Events
- You may enter up to 3 x classes/rounds per show (only 1 class counts towards series points)
- Each Horse and Rider combination can only compete in one Series. Series points
  are accumulated from <u>one</u> nominated class in this Series at <u>four</u> shows of your
  choice. This class must be nominated before the combination's first round of
  competition at each show.
- If no nomination is made, the first competition class will be counted.

- Please indicate your nominated class when you enter and confirm this class with the judges before your first round of the show.
- In the event of there being a tie in the number of Series Points accrued by the end of the Series

The winners will be decided by adding up the least number of jump faults in the four nominated classes and then by the fastest times, jump off times or in the case of Classes 1 & 2 the times that are closest to the Optimum Time

- Horses & Ponies will jump the same courses. There will be no combination fences
- You may enter the same class twice, however only your first round will count towards series points.
- NB It may be possible to win a class on the day with your 2nd or 3rd round of the Class but only your first round will count for Series Points

Frequently asked questions about accruing Series points

Q: If I nominate Class 3, 70cm to accrue Level Zero Series Points can I jump in the lowest class of Level One - Class 4 75cm

A: Yes. But you cannot jump in Level One - Class 5 80cm

- Q: If in a subsequent show in the series I want to jump in Level One Class 5 80cm can I still nominate Class 3 70cm as my nominated class to accrue Level Zero Series Points?
- A: No. You cannot use Level Zero Class 3 70cm as your nominated Class if you jump in Level One Class 5 80cm. By entering and jumping in Class 5 80cm you are considered to be competing in the Level One Series.
- Q: If I do jump in Level One Class 5 80cm will the Level Zero Series Points I accrued previously by nominating Class 3 (which is Level Zero) be counted in my Level One Series tally.

A: No.

Hopefully, this helps to clarify the rules.

**Series Points Allocation** 

Points will be allocated for each class as follows:

(Eliminations, retirements or greater than 12 faults will not gain points regardless of class numbers.)

Points	Assuming 5 + Eligible Entries	If less than 5 Eligible Entries
1st	5	5
2nd	4	4
3rd	3	3
4th	2	2
5th	1	

Eligible Entries = 1st Rounds in a Class & Completed rounds with less than 12 faults
